American Councils for International Education, a non-profit organization committed to international education worldwide is looking for temporary host families for young professionals (ages 25-35) from Eurasia under the auspices of the State Departments Bureau of Educational and Cultural Affairs.

This federally-funded fellowship program is sponsored by the U.S. Department of State's Bureau of Educational and Cultural Affairs. The Program targets emerging leaders who are pursuing careers in both the public and private sectors.

### PROGRAM FACTS:

- Hosting commitment: April 27 – May 29, 2017
- Fellows work with local, state and federal legislatures/government offices, NGOs, academic institutions and other organizations across the country.
- During the program, Fellows live in home stays and are supported by American Councils staff.
- Fellows receive a roundtrip ticket from their home country, medical insurance, a modest stipend, and an allowance for public transportation.
- Upon their return home, Fellows administer projects and conduct workshops in cooperation with the U.S. Embassy and U.S. counterparts.
